

## 2013 PROTOCOL FOR STUDENT PLACEMENT IN WRITING AND MATH

(April 9, 2013 – Approved by Deans' Council)

**WRITING PLACEMENT:** Placement in writing is based on a point value using a combination of the following criteria: SAT Verbal and Writing scores, final course grades in 9th, 10th, and 11th English grades and if available, the New York State English Language Arts (ELA) exam scores.

<b>Option 1: SAT WRITING, NYS ELA</b>		
<p><b>WRT 100 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score of 785 or higher using: - SAT Writing - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English - NYS ELA exam scores</p>	<p><b>DEV WRT Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score below 785 using: - SAT Writing - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English - NYS ELA exam score <i>In addition, a student must have a SAT Verbal score of 500 or higher</i></p>	<p><b>CRL 101 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score below 785 using: - SAT Writing - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English - NYS ELA exam score <i>In addition, a student must have a SAT Verbal score below 500</i></p>
<b>Option 2: SAT Writing, No NYS ELA</b>

<b>Option 3: NYS ELA but no SAT</b>		
<p><b>WRT 100 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score of 310 or higher using: - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English - NYS ELA exam score</p>	<p><b>DEV WRT Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score between 300 and 310 using: - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English - NYS ELA exam score</p>	<p><b>CRL 101 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score below 300 using: - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English - NYS ELA exam score</p>
<b>Option 4: No NYS ELA and no SAT</b>		
<p><b>WRT 100 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score of 240 or higher using: - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English</p>	<p><b>DEV WRT Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score between 220 and 240 using: - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English</p>	<p><b>CRL 101 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score below 220 using: - Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th English</p>

**MATH PLACEMENT:** Placement in math is based on a point value using a combination of the following criteria: SAT Math score, final course grades in 9th, 10th, and 11th grade mathematics courses, and, if available, the New York State Integrated Algebra Regents exam score or Algebra II / Trigonometry Regents exam score.

In the chart below, DEV MATH indicates the need for a development (Y) section of MAT 102 (if the student enrolls in that course) and for completion of MAT 106 before enrolling in MAT 107. Students with a REG MATH recommendation may be placed in MAT 107 or a regular section of MAT 102. Those with either of those recommendations (but not with an LSK recommendation) may enroll in MAT 105 or MAT 251.

<b>Option 2: SAT Math but no NYS Integrated Algebra Regents Exam Score (Old Option 3)</b>		
<p><b>REG MATH Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score of 720 or higher using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- SAT Math</li> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10th &amp; 11th math</li> </ul>	<p><b>DEV MATH Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score between 670 and 719 using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- SAT Math</li> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10th &amp; 11th math</li> </ul>	<p><b>LSK 095 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score below 670 using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- SAT Math</li> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10th &amp; 11th math</li> </ul>
<b>Option 3: NYS Integrated Algebra Regents Exam Score but no SAT Math (Old Option 5)</b>		
<p><b>REG MATH Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score of 300 or higher using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10th &amp; 11th math</li> <li>- NYS Integrated Algebra Regents Exam Score</li> </ul>	<p><b>DEV MATH Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score between 280-299 using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10th &amp; 11th math</li> <li>- NYS Integrated Algebra Regents Exam Score</li> </ul>	<p><b>LSK 095 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score below 280 using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th math</li> <li>- NYS Integrated Algebra Regents Exam Score</li> </ul>
<b>Option 4: No SAT Math or NYS Integrated Algebra Regents Exam Score (Old Option 6)</b>		
<p><b>REG MATH Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score of 220 or higher using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th math</li> </ul>	<p><b>DEV MATH Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score between 205 and 219 using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th math</li> </ul>	<p><b>LSK 095 Recommendation:</b> A student who has a total score below 205 using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Final grades in 9th, 10<sup>th</sup> &amp; 11th math</li> </ul>

**Precalculus and Calculus:** A student must have an REG MATH recommendation in order to register for MAT 109 (otherwise he/she should be placed in LSK 095 or in MAT 106, depending on whether the recommendation is LSK or DEV MATH). **In addition:**

least an 85 on MATH 11 will be placed in ***MAT 111, Calculus I.***

will be placed in ***MAT 109, Pre-calculus.***
