

Study Abroad Program not affiliated with Niagara University

Students, who wish to study through an outside institution for a semester program with an international focus that is not technically study abroad, must attend a program with at least 3 courses that are international in topic. The program and the courses must be approved by the Dean of their College and the courses must count towards their degree. Students who are approved for such study must return to Niagara University in the subsequent semester in order to have their Niagara University merit-based scholarship reinstated. Students should complete a Course Advisement Form for Study Abroad and receive appropriate approvals from their advisor, their dean and the study abroad coordinator.

Students attending these programs will be technically withdrawn from the university and upon readmission to Niagara their institutional merit-based scholarship will be reinstated.
