

## **Peer Tutoring**

The Office of Academic Support's tutoring program offers tutoring in many introductory university courses at no charge to students who request the service. Peer tutors are trained and closely supervised by the OAS tutor coordinator and must meet academic eligibility criteria established by the university. The extensive tutor training program holds national certification awarded by the College Reading and Learning Association.

Students who request a tutor generally agree to meet in a one-on-one or small group setting for a minimum of two hours per week. To initiate the request, a student must complete a "Tutor Request Form," available in the OAS and on the OAS website.

Faculty may recommend outstanding students in their classes to the OAS whom they feel would make skillful and knowledgeable tutors.
