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Guidelines:

1. Students requesting academic accommodations for a medical history of seizure activity will be directed to the Coordinator of Disability Services for the implementation and review of the University's Seizure Protocol.
2. The Director of Health Services will work collaborate with the Coordinator of Disability Services in this effort.
3. Director of Health Services will review suggested care plan and discuss with clinic mid-level provider and medical director.
4. Clinic medical director will provide final approval and sign care plan.
5. Care plans are valid for one academic year unless otherwise stated.
